### **Books**

Author Surname, Initial. (DATE) *Title of Book*. Publication place: Publishing House.

- One author

#### Example:

Gilbert, N. (2007) *Agent-based Models*. London: SAGE.

- Two authors

#### Example:

Frank, R. H. and Bernanke, B. (2007) *Principles of macro-economics* Boston: McGraw-Hill/Irwin.

### **Edited book**

Author Surname, Initial. (Ed. / Eds.) (DATE) *Title of Book* (edition). Publication place: Publishing House.

#### Example:

Gibbs, J. T. and Huang, L. N. (Eds.) (2001) *Children of color: Psychological interventions with culturally diverse youth* (3<sup>rd</sup>. ed). San Francisco: Jossey-Bass.

### **Chapter in edited books**

Author Surname, Initial. (DATE) Title of Chapter. In Initial. Editor Surname (Ed. / Eds.) *Title of Book*. Publication place: Publishing House.

#### Examples:

Labajo, J. (2003) Body and voice: The construction of gender in flamenco. In T. Magrini (Ed.) *Music and gender: perspectives from the Mediterranean*. Chicago: University of Chicago Press.

Hammond, K. R. and Adelman, L. (1986) Science, values, and human judgment. In H. R. Arkes and K. R. Hammond (Eds.) *Judgement and decision making: An interdisciplinary reader*. Cambridge: Cambridge University Press.

## Articles in journals, magazines, and newspapers

Author Surname, Initial. (DATE) Title of Article. *Journal Title*, Volume(Number), page numbers.

### Example:

Ku, G. (2008) Learning to de-escalate: The effects of regret in escalation of commitment. *Organizational Behavior and Human Decision Processes*, 105(2), 221-232.

- Journal article, more than one authors, available online

### Example:

Gilbert, N., Pyka, A. and Ahrweiler, P. (2001) Innovation Networks: A Simulation Approach. *Journal of Artificial Societies and Social Simulation*, 4 (3) 182-196.

Available from <http://jasss.soc.surrey.ac.uk/4/3/8.html>

- Article from an Internet-only journal

### Example:

## Magazine or Newspaper article

Author Surname, Initial. (FULL DATE) Title of Article. *Magazine/Newspaper Title*, Volume(Number) when available, page numbers.

### Example:

Kluger, J. (2008, January 28) Why we love. *Time*, 171(4), 54-60.

## Conference Papers

Author Surname, Initial. (DATE) Title of Paper. Paper presented at Name of Conference, Location, Full Date.

### Example:

Rahman, R. Hales, D., Vinko, T., Pouwelse, J. and Sips, H. (2010) *No more crash or crunch: sustainable credit dynamics in a P2P community*. Paper presented at the

International Conference on High Performance Computing & Simulation (HPCS 2010), Caen, France, 12-15 June 2010.

- Published in Conference Proceedings

Author Surname, Initial. (DATE) *Title of Paper*. In Proceedings of Name of Conference, Location, page numbers.

Examples:

Ormándi, R., Hegedús, I., Csernai, K. and Jelasity, M. (2010) *Towards inferring ratings from user behavior in BitTorrent communities*. In Proceedings of the 6th International Workshop on Collaborative Peer-to-Peer Systems (COPS) at WETICE'10, IEEE Computer Society, 2010, 217–222.

- Available online

Add at the end: Available from URL

- Available online only

Add at the end: <URL>

- Available from an electronic database

Add at the end: doi (digital object identifier)

- Available from an electronic database only

Add at the end: <doi>
